### Project Brief

The extension of the Wm Morrison Wakefield Plant bakery site and the installation of an automated tin bread line.

The multi-million pound investment enables the line to operate at 'world class' manufacturing efficiency levels by utilising the very latest industry specific technology.

### Solutions

We were responsible for the design of all building services into the new facility including :

- HV Supplies
- LV Infrastructure
- Compressed Air
- Towns / Chilled / LPH Water & Steam

We also designed the lighting and power requirements for the extensions and all equipment to be installed. This involved the design and planning of shared services within the existing bakery with zero disruption to the 24/7 operation during the project.
